TREASURER'S REPORT - As of the end of July, we were current on all of our obligations. Our General Fund Contributions for July were \$2,369.80 more than budgeted. While this is good news, it must be tempered with the fact that we had 5 Sundays in July which minimizes the magnitude of this good news. As has been noted, we resorted to the use of the line of credit in June and now have a \$27,000 balance to repay. The board of finance has been struggling to develop a strategy for the repayment of this balance, and has as of yet not developed a plan. Please pray for guidance for us in this and all aspects of our church finances as we continue to struggle financially.

LUTHERAN CHURCH AND SCHOOL OF THE MESSIAH ENDOWMENT FUND

We have received our Fund Statement for January 1, 2017 to June 30, 2017 from the <u>Lutheran Church and School of the Messiah Endowment Fund</u> managed By <u>Western Colorado Community Foundation</u>. The "Beginning Total Fund Balance" was \$139,200.49 and the "End Total Fund Balance" was \$142,849.12. This is an increase of \$3,648.63 or 2.62% on our balance. There were no "Available Fund to Distribute" as distribution are received in December. Distribution, when received, are deposited to the <u>School Scholarship</u> account. Anyone wishing to contribute to the <u>Lutheran Church and School of the Messiah Endowment Fund</u> can do so by Contacting the <u>Western Colorado Community Foundation</u> at 225 N 5th St #505, on the 5th floor in the Alpine Bank building. Donations to the <u>School Scholarship</u> fund are also welcomed, these scholarships are used to assist those families who struggle financially, with tuition for their children attending our school.
