LINE OF CREDIT CHALLENGE - Each donation made to pay off the Line of Credit will be matched, up to \$9,500.00.

LINE OF CREDIT - In June 2017 we were forced to take an advance of \$27,000 on our Line of Credit with LCEF due to low contributions. The line of Credit must be paid off each year with a \$0.00 balance for one month of that year. Making the minimum payments from the time it was drawn would still leave us with around a \$25,000 balance by May of 2018. With your special contributions, we have currently been able to pay \$7,250 to the line of credit. There are envelopes on the east wall of the narthex for giving to the paying off our Line of Credit. Select an amount, or select a blank envelop and fill in the amount then drop it in with your regular offering. Please prayerfully consider helping pay off our Line of Credit.
