TREASURER'S REPORT - Eph. 3: 20-21 "Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think. . . to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen." God delights in exceeding expectations and in pouring out mercies in abundance. This truth stands in contrast to our fears about lacking what we need for "this body and life." We have an abundantly blessing God who has proven His love for us on the cross. How could we not trust Him? How could we not respond to His love with generosity and a desire to imitate Him in blessing others? (LCMS Stewardship Ministry - Resources)

As of August 15, we were almost current with our bills, the only outstanding accounts were for payroll liabilities (taxes, etc.) in the amount of \$997.51. However, we must remember that we had five (5) Sundays in July, and school registration the beginning of August, which provided an influx of revenue that will not be sustained with our current level of giving. As of July 31st, we had paid \$10,035.28 less in expense than was budgeted. This was because we had not paid several bills (District Support, Mortgage, Gas & Electric, etc). Other than the District Support, these were made current after school registration. Please remember that

our work plan indicates that we will have monthly expenses of \$7,899.53 more than our monthly income. Prayfully consider what we can do to reconcile that short fall, and please continue to pray that we would have the financial ability to carry out the missions that God has chosen for us here at Messiah.

MESSIAH CHURCH FAMILY, We have welcomed back 110 students and their families for another year of learning and growing! We are excited to see familiar faces as well as MANY new ones! Our students and staff need your constant prayer and support. We would love for EACH FAMILY that attends Messiah to partner with us again this year and join us in our efforts of training up these children in the way that they should go, according to the Lord.

Are you able to help us and be a Prayer Partner this year? Make sure you look to see all the children's faces on the Narthex wall. Take one, or two, and remember to sign your name next to theirs on their class list!

Keep in mind, your only "job/responsibility/commitment" is to pray for whomever you choose. However, we want to build relationships through this program. If you are a Prayer Partner, you WILL BE invited to come eat lunch with the children once a month, usually the 2nd Friday @11:30am, at our "Prayer Partner Lunch Bunch." Our first LUNCH BUNCH will be September 14th, in the Fellowship Hall. The children LOVE getting to know you!!!
