TREASURER'S REPORT - LCEF Line of Credit

As you will remember, at the May Congregational Meeting we accepted an annual workplan with Total Income of \$942,047,00 and Total Expenses of \$1,036,846.36, which gave us a Net Income of **negative** \$94,799.36. This means that we committed to spend 10% more than we projected taking in.

At the end of September our expenses were \$242,375.26 and we had borrowed \$15,000 from our LCEF Line of Credit at the beginning of August to meet expenses. This means that we borrowed funds to pay about 6.2% of our expenses. At this

rate, we can anticipate that we will need to borrow at least \$60,000 from the Line of Credit by the end of the fiscal year. This is in addition to \$23,000 we borrowed in the 2017-18 fiscal year, or a total of \$83,000 we will have borrowed. We have received some gracious gifts which reduced the balance at the end of September from \$38,000 to \$35,300.

Please consider an additional Special Gift to help with our Line of Credit debt. You can either use one of the envelopes under the Pay Down Our Line of Credit poster in the narthex or one of your Special/Designated Gift envelopes from your Managing God's Gifts envelopes.
