**TREASURER'S REPORT - CORRECTION**

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

December historically provides the highest income of any month of the year. This December provided sufficient income for us to get our bills current and pay most of our bills in January. Historically February yields less income than any other month but June. This February was no exception and we quickly fell behind again.

We were able to make payroll on February 28 but had to borrow from the line of credit to pay payroll expense and several large bills including the first half of our property taxes, the mortgage, Xcel, Church Mutual and the water. We borrowed \$22,500 to cover these expenses, bringing the amount borrowed this fiscal year to ~~\$49,500~~ \$53,500. This is about ~~\$9,000~~ \$5,000 less than our projected deficit on the work plan. While having borrowed \$5,000 less than our projected deficit, the \$9,957.91 of unpaid bills leaves our deficit \$5,000 greater than projected for the end of February. *We have the listed bills that we have no funds to pay.*
