### **Zephaniah 1:7, 12** ***What's On the Menu?***

Thanksgiving is on the way in 1 ½ weeks! What's going to be the main course on your table?

- Try to imagine being the turkey in the cartoon above. What's going through his mind vs. what's going to happen to him?
- The people had become complacent in their faith and relationship to God. 'Complacent' in Hebrew is 'dregs'. Dregs is what's at the bottom of the container when people make wine or beer. It's useless and waste.
- The people had been shaped like and by the culture around them. They were more concerned about keeping the empty religious laws of false gods than keeping God's laws. In what ways can the Christian be shaped by the world around us?
- In the parable (Gospel reading) the one who received 1 talent used his faith like a good luck charm. If it's true, he was set. If it wasn't true then he lost nothing, What are some things that make you complacent with God?
- Judgment Day is coming whether you believe it or not, or whether the culture believes it or not. Are you really ready?
- Jesus is your Sacrifice. Through faith in Christ alone, you have nothing to fear!

**STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT** - “And cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness” (Matthew 25:30a). Why did the worthless servant act the way he did? Because of what he believed about the Master. He didn't trust or love the Master. So, his actions did not demonstrate love and trust but rather hate and mistrust. It's the same with us, but in reverse.
