## Epistle

*2 Corinthians 3:12-18; 4:1-6*

<sup>12</sup>Since we have such a hope, we are very bold, <sup>13</sup>not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face so that the Israelites might not gaze at the outcome of what was being brought to an end. <sup>14</sup>But their minds were hardened. For to this day, when they read the old covenant, that same veil remains unlifted, because only through Christ is it taken away. <sup>15</sup>Yes, to this day whenever Moses is read a veil lies over their hearts. <sup>16</sup>But when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. <sup>17</sup>Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. <sup>18</sup>And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. ### **STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS-**

Luke 18:34 - "This saying was hidden from them, and they did not grasp what was said." Even our understanding of the Word of God is a gift - the disciples can't understand Jesus because it is not given to them to understand him. By nature they are deaf to the Word.
