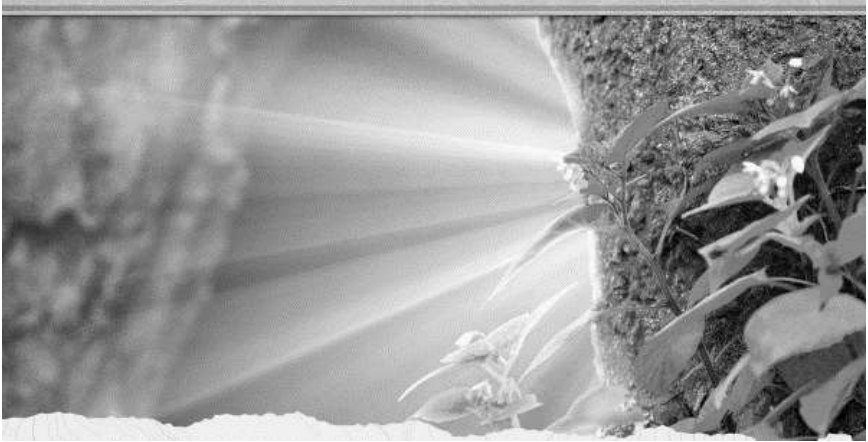


PLACES OF THE PASSION: EASTER SUNDAY: THE GARDEN TOMB



“Now in the place where he was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid. So because of the Jewish day of Preparation, since the tomb was close at hand, they laid Jesus there.”

John 19:41-42

Journey with Jesus through the Holy Land, listening to Him teach, witnessing miracles, and discovering how our Savior fulfills the prophecies of the Old Testament.

These meditations for Lent, inspired by theology professor Reed Lessing, follow Christ with an eye toward the places of the Passion where He suffers, dies, and rises again for our salvation.

Every place that Jesus goes along His path hints at His ultimate mission to take your place for redemption so that you might have a place in heaven with Him forever.

(During 10:30am service, Confession and Absolution, the Creed, and the Lords Prayer are included in the baptism rite.)

Confession and Forgiveness (6:00am)

P Forgive me, O Lord, when my besetting sins entangle me and completely surround me.

C Who will rescue?

P For give me, Lord, when I am so eager to get, but so reluctant to give, so ready to receive your gifts, but so unwilling to bear the cross.

P Father, forgive me when I rejoice in the temporary but think little of the eternal; when I am so fond of being idle but show little passion for helpful service.

C Lord, have mercy! Christ, have mercy! Lord, have mercy!

(Please silently reflect on the fact that though our sin is great, Christ’s love is greater.)

P Hear the good news! Jesus went to places of rejection, suffering, torment and death- for you. Jesus was determined to go to Gethsemane,

Gabbatha, and Golgotha- for you. And Jesus lives for you! That's why Jesus forgives you completely and loves you eternally in the name of the Father † and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Faithful Lord, with me abide!

C I shall follow where you guide!

P Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the † Son and of the Holy Spirit.
